PROGRESS REPORT ON OFF-SITE SHORT COURSES: 2008-2010

Introduction

Off-site Short Courses are conducted in response to organization's training needs. The training is offered to mid and senior level managers as well as staff involved in HIV/AIDS activities at national, district, facility and community level.

Progress to-date:

A total of 1,100 individuals were supported through short courses from 32 institutions between April 2008 and September 2010.

Table showing number of individuals supported through short courses: April 2008 – September 30, 2010

The courses offered included grants and proposal writing, monitoring and evaluation of HIV/AIDS programs, advocacy and resource mobilization strategies, design and implementation of HIV/AIDS programs, finance for non-finance managers, behavior change communication, and strategic leadership and management, among others. Majority of the trainees (62%) were males.
